After a summer of exciting opportunities working with children and young people, we are enjoying a short break during the last week of August. As we look back, we are thankful for the many opportunities to serve in the community through bible camps and various outreaches.

We are thankful for the excellent teaching this summer at the **Bible camp**, challenging the children to examine what they value and treasure the most, store up treasures in heaven, and turn to Jesus. The team worked hard in engaging the children and youth in small group work and we were all thrilled to hear reports that the children have been sharing the message they heard at camp in their homes. One highlight of camp this year was the open prayer times where many children took part.



Through our **Skills program** which ran throughout the whole summer, we offered one-to-one study opportunities for students who were behind with their schooling and for those who needed to take resits, so they wouldn't have to repeat a school year. Although not as well attended as we would have liked, it was good to spend time with young people and connect with their parents.



Through the summer we organised guitar and Cajon teaching classes for young people. The teen boys in particular were enthusiastic about the Cajon, and we would like to continue this course in the future. It is our prayer that from this group would come those who can serve leading worship in the future.



Many young people have been passionate about the **football training** Csaba ran in July, and we were especially grateful for a team from Exodus who helped us. Each day the boys listened attentively to the challenging talks and testimonies, and we pray for growth from the seeds of God's word.



On July 20th, we attended the gypsy mission national football championship and to our delight, both Bodaszóli FC teams won the trophy in their respective age groups.

In September we will hold a family service in September where we hope families of children who have attended the summer outreaches will come along. In September we will start a regular youth group and begin a series called Foundations.
