One of the leaders of the Generation Impact discipleship course shares the experience of 4 weeks in Tuum.

“Praise the Lord, our time as missionaries at Tuum for the past one month was great. We exalt the name of Jesus for the opportunity. Isaiah 45:2 says “I will go before you...” We had prepared for the mission but most of us had no experience of Samburu. We knew neither the culture of the Samburu people nor the terrain of the place. We arrived at Tuum and we were warmly received by SAAP management. In fact, we’re glad a vehicle was sent to bring us from Maralal all the way to Tuum. This saved us of the fears of insecurity and delay and confirmed that SAAP were eager to receive us. Our mission exposure was a successful one due to provision of accommodation, and moral, social and spiritual support. During the season, we were able to interact with the local community through work, making of hay, construction work and some in garage work. Though there was a language barrier the love of Christ was communicated. Some local people appreciated work as worship to God. We also had opportunity to share the gospel in six schools and in the very remote places of Keleswa, Seren and Wuaso Rongai. We thank God for the vehicles He provided through SAAP. The monthly teaching seminar was another learning experience for us. We pray that God will continue to provide labourers in Samburu as much work is still available. Key lessons we learnt were endurance, patience, commitment and reliance on God. Thanks, be blessed.” Gibson.
